SELECTION PROCESS AND AWARD

The process for selecting recipients of the scholarship will be through an impartial selection procedure established by the Board of Directors of the Robertson Scholarship Foundation. A personal interview may be required. Last year a four-year scholarship for \$1,000 was awarded. The Haywood County Schools Foundation, Inc., a tax-exempt charitable foundation, will administer the scholarship fund.

Eligibility

To be eligible, a student must be currently enrolled in a Haywood County High School, and a graduating senior. Student must be planning to attend an approved secondary program (technical/community college, junior college, four-year institution), and have a 2.5 or better GPA.

Scholarship Award

Checks shall be written on a quarter/semester basis to the institution contingent upon the student's continued good standing. Payment shall be made upon invoice received from the officer of the registrar of the respective college/university. For a renewal scholarship a copy of the previous semester grades is required to be submitted to the Foundation before further payment will occur. A minimum of a 2.5 GPA is required and recipient must be a full-time registered student to continue receiving the scholarship. *Receiving full scholarships from other sources may eliminate eligibility for certain HCSF scholarships. The HCSF reserves the right to revoke scholarships if guidelines are not met.* Scholarship affidavits will be collected from all recipients before payments are finalized.
